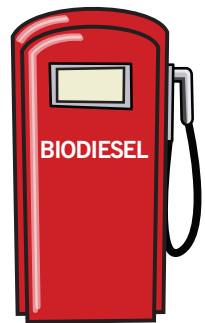
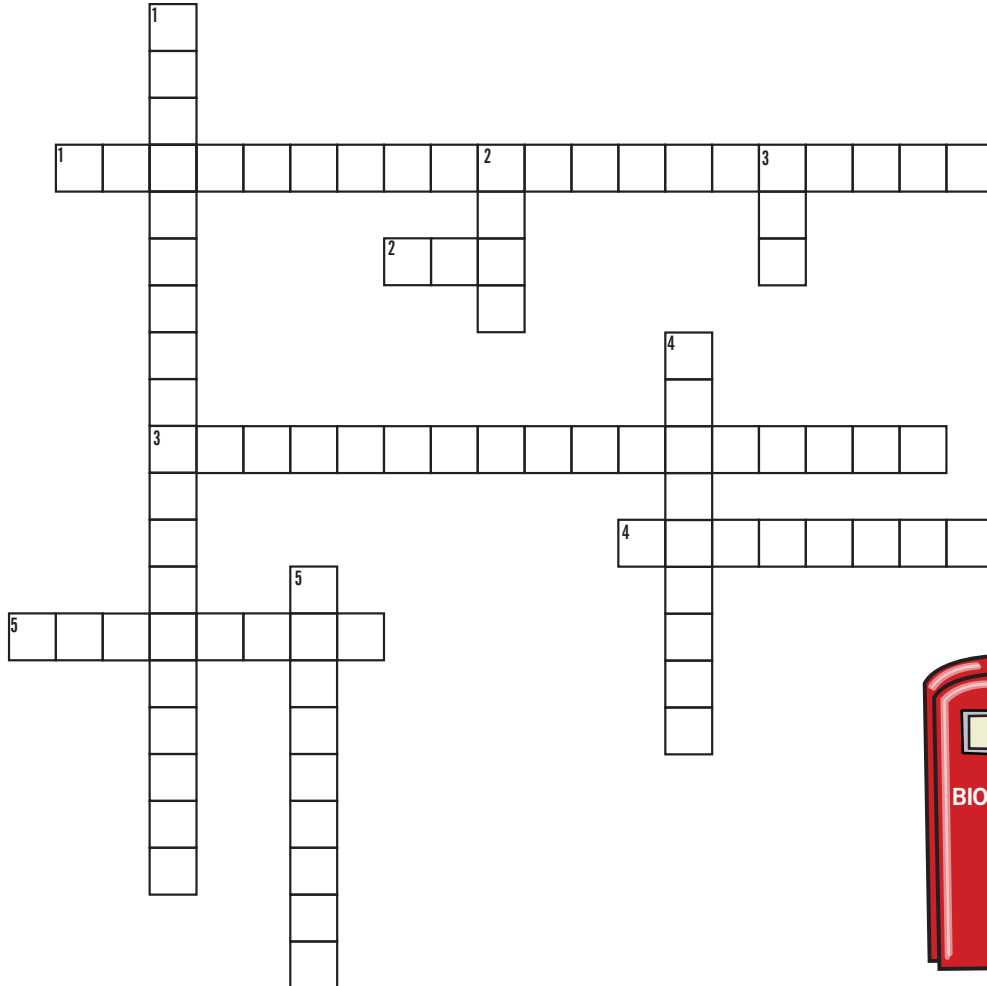




Biodiesel, *the* EARTH LOVING FUEL



ACROSS

- Fuel that cannot be easily made or renewed. It is used up.
- A blend of 20 percent biodiesel with 80 percent petroleum diesel.
- Fuel that can be renewed or easily made.
- A substance that is not toxic or poisonous.
- A waste by-product of the biodiesel making process.

DOWN

- The process of removing glycerin from soybean oil.
- Pure biodiesel fuel.
- A black liquid fossil fuel found deep in the Earth. Gasoline and most plastics are made from this.
- How a liquid is resistant to flow; thickness or thinness.
- An environmentally safe, low polluting fuel for most diesel internal combustion and turbine engines.
