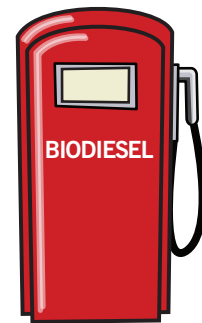
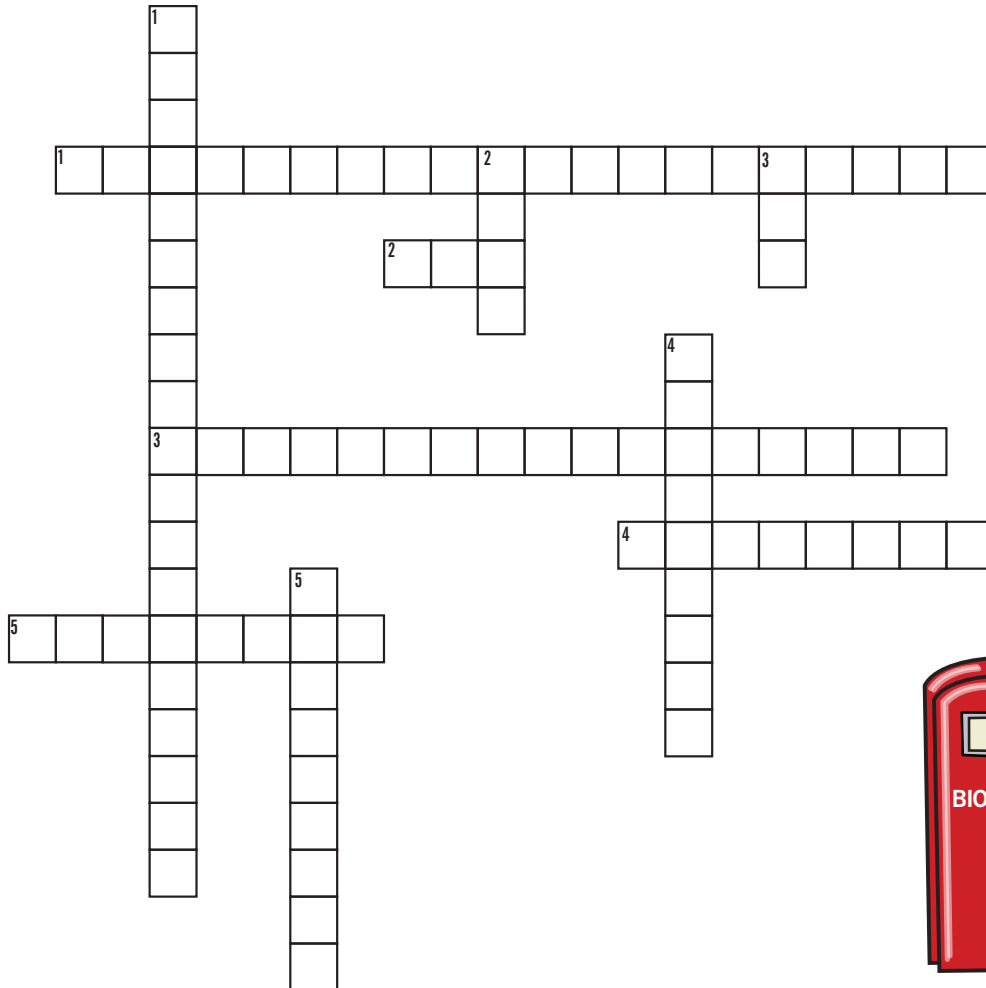




Biodiesel, *the* EARTH LOVING FUEL
